

# Anchor Post Instructions

## Anchor Post Instructions

(Tools needed: 1/2" wrench, 9/16" wrench, large screwdriver or solid bar)

1. Slide Auger into Anchor Post and secure by bolting through with the provided 3/8" x 2-1/2" long hex bolt and nut.
2. Slide (4) 5/16" x 1-3/4" long carriage bolts into the track system at the location the Anchor Post is to be mounted.
3. Connect the Mounting Bracket loosely to the Dock Frame track system with the Anchor Post sandwiched in between using the carriage bolts installed in step 2 w/ 5/16" nuts and washers. The Mounting Bracket loosely installed will act as a guide to keep the Anchor Post vertical during installation
4. Taking care to make sure the Anchor Post is vertical, use a large screwdriver or solid bar to spin the Anchor Post into the lake bottom by using the installation hole on the top of the Anchor Post.
5. Once the Anchor Post is in position (preferably a foot or more into the lake bottom), finish fastening the Mounting Bracket to the dock frame by tightening the (4) 5/16" hex nuts.

\*It should not take significant effort for the Auger to bite the lake bottom and go down in. If it becomes very difficult to spin you may have hit a rock or difficult bottom composition.
